



# Care and Maintenance Guide



## Protection Tips

- Place area rugs or mats to trap dirt, grit, and sand in front of all entrances. Clean them regularly.
- Stick pads under furniture, shelves, and chair legs to prevent scratches, clean pads when necessary.
- Avoid spiked shoes or high heels protruding the floor from a sole point.
- Avoid placing objects more than 200kg over one square meter area.
- Avoid dragging heavy objects over floor area, such as bookcases, natural marble kitchen units, et al.
- Keep pets' claws well-trimmed to reduce scratches.



## Regular Cleaning

- Use a broom, vacuum, or dust mop to clean out debris, grit, sand, and dust regularly.
- Use a damp cloth or sponge to remove spills immediately.
- Avoid using scouring pads, abrasive cleaners, steel wool, as they are prone to scratch and damage the floor.
- Avoid using steam mop or flood the floor.
- Avoid using oil, wax, soap, bleaches, or polishes as they may etch or bring dull finish on the floor.
- Use PH-Neutral detergents to clean scuffs and stains.
- Use concentrated PH-Neutral detergents or methylated alcohols to clean stubborn scuffs and stains. Dilute methylated spirits should be rinsed completely from the floor.
- Use a damp mop regularly, do not allow excessive water leaving on the floor.

MTF laminate floors are designed to be installed in internal environment, not suitable for outdoor areas, bathrooms, and laundry rooms. Although MTF laminate floors is superior robust and durable, to achieve a longer lifespan, we suggest,

## To achieve an optimal performance of your floor

Laminate floorboards can be subject to small cupping, shrinkage, and gapping when weather conditions change or extreme weather conditions last, boards will recover after the weather is back to normal. This is considered a natural laminate characteristic, not product failures. It would be the best if floor users maintain indoor temperature stable and in the proper range mentioned below.

- Room temperature is recommended to maintain 10°C-30°C and relative humidity between 40%-60%. Rapid fluctuations in temperatures and humidity may cause board joints lipping/gapping. Those dimensional changes can also cause floor squeaking.
- Window awnings/blinds/curtains are recommended to protect floorboards from direct exposure to sunlights. Fierce sunlights may cause floorboards temperature more than 60°C and prolonged sunlights would fade floor areas.
- Colour shade variations can be caused by uneven or partial sunlight exposures. Rearrange room furniture, decorative items, rugs, and plants periodically would help preventing this.
